Ritchie Precision acknowledges its responsibility within the supply chain. Like many other sub-contractors, Ritchie Precision too is aware of the problem that products and components purchased from suppliers may contain minerals from conflict regions. We work with our suppliers to ensure appropriate due diligence so that we can continue to source responsibly, building on established management processes.

Commitment

We are committed to avoiding the use, within our supply chain, of minerals from conflict affected and high-risk areas which are affected by the risks defined in Annex 2 of the OECD Due Diligence Guidance.
